'TRENDING' AT MILAN 2014

With established brands, there was a focus on continuity and the introduction of new takes on popular designs. This was evidenced, amongst many others, by [Paul Smith's collaboration](#) with [Carl Hansen & Son](#), [Vitra's](#) presentation of the classic [Eames Aluminum Chair](#) in a new range of vibrant colours and [Fritz Hansen's](#) reintroduction of [Arne Jacobsen's Drop Chair](#).

The use of fewer materials with an emphasis on a product's craftsmanship and its functionality was very much on display. Examples were numerous and standouts included works found at the Salone Internazionale del Mobile [DANISH LIVINGroom](#) stand, American brand [BassamFellows](#) and the Italian company [Discipline](#). Many newly discovered and promising (typically younger) designers housed at the [SaloneSatellite](#) and [Ventura Lambrate](#), eschewed technological advances in design, choosing instead to present cleverly crafted pieces. Notable designs were introduced by [Federico Peri](#) ([Biblioteca Itinerante](#)), [Guglielmo Poletti](#) ([linescapes](#)), [Vij5](#) ([Strap Stool](#)), [Olga Bielawska](#) ([Circle Meets Square](#)) and [Rick Tegelaar](#) ([Meshmatics](#)).
